



**BioWorks Announces OMRI Listing for
CEASE™ Biological Fungicide**

Victor, New York (July 24, 2008) – BioWorks, Inc. is pleased to announce that the Organic Materials Review Institute (OMRI) has reviewed the company's EPA registered fungicide CEASE Microbial Fungicide, based on *Bacillus subtilis* strain QST 713, and approved the listing of CEASE for use in organic production.

CEASE, labeled as both a foliar spray and soil drench on nursery and greenhouse ornamentals, trees, shrubs, flowering plants, and covered vegetable crops, is a broad spectrum biofungicide targeting common fungal and bacterial diseases such as *Botrytis*, *Pseudomonas*, *Erwinia*, powdery mildew, leaf spot and speck, anthracnose, and rust.

CEASE has a four-hour restricted entry interval and a zero-day pre-harvest interval providing growers minimal interruption following sprays. *Bacillus subtilis*, QST 713 strain was formerly sold under the RHAPSODY brand in the U.S. ornamental market.
