Application Directions

Citrus Orchards

Apply 3 - 25 oz of PlantShield HC per acre for control of *Hyphoderma sambuci* (Hyphoderma gummosis pathogen). Dilute 3 – 25 oz of PlantShield HC in 100 to 500 gallons of water. Apply using a high volume spray (non-air assisted) or by hand application with a paint brush. Apply to tree pruning wounds as soon as possible after pruning or within 4 to 5 days. Make one to two applications to fresh pruning wounds. Applications should be done at temperatures above 48° F.

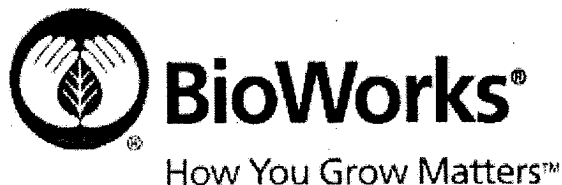
Application Timing: Applications must only be made after harvest, when trees are dormant and no blooms are present. Do not apply when harvestable food commodities (fruit) are present.

- Use Restrictions:**
- This product must not be tank mixed with chemicals that contain the following active ingredients: benomyl, imazalil, propiconazole, tebuconazole, fenbuconazole, and triflumizole.
 - Do not apply to nursery-size lemon trees. Apply to mature trees only. Replants or trees planted within the last three years (third leaf) should not be treated. Turn off boom sprayers while passing trees that were planted less than three years ago.
 - Do not apply to lemon trees within 30 days of harvest.

Restricted Entry Interval (REI): For field applications: Keep unprotected persons out of treated areas until sprays have dried or dusts have settled.
